STUDY AREA

The Vashatkara Foundation's skill development initiatives focus on empowering underserved communities, including persons with disabilities (PWDs), through vocational training and employment support. While specific details about the study areas are not explicitly mentioned on the foundation's website, the foundation's commitment to social welfare and community empowerment suggests that their programs are designed to address the needs of various groups, including the general public and PWDs.

These initiatives aim to enhance employability, build confidence, and promote social inclusion among participants. By offering tailored training and support, the foundation strives to create opportunities for individuals to achieve financial independence and contribute meaningfully to society.

VASHATKARA WORKING PROGRESS

At Vashatkara Foundation, our skill development program is designed to empower individuals by enhancing their vocational skills and fostering self-reliance. The process is structured as follows:

1. Community Engagement: We initiate the program by engaging with local communities to identify the specific needs and aspirations of the participants.

2. Curriculum Design: Based on the community feedback, we develop a tailored curriculum that addresses the identified skill gaps and aligns with market demands.

3. Training Delivery: Skilled trainers conduct interactive sessions, combining theoretical knowledge with practical applications to ensure comprehensive learning.

4. Assessment and Certification: Participants undergo assessments to evaluate their proficiency. Successful candidates receive certifications that validate their skills.

5.Placement Support: We collaborate with local businesses and industries to facilitate job placements for the trained individuals, ensuring they have opportunities to apply their skills in real-world settings.

Through this structured approach, Vashatkara aims to bridge the skill gap, enhance employability, and contribute to the socio-economic development of the community.



1. Remuneration -

- We entirely cover the cost of the modest remuneration that we can offer to our teachers. However, we are finding it difficult to maintain this process due to a lack of funding and limited financial resources.

2. Stationery -

- Education is important and so are the resources related to it. In order to provide the children with quality education and proper guidance, we need stationery items to make learning impactful and fun. Children are helpless due to which they cannot buy their own stationery items; so, we provide them with stationeries at our own expense but it is not possible to keep on doing this.

3. Skill development

- Today, every child has some talent hidden deep inside them, but there is no one to help them expose themselves.
- To bring out their skills, we organize various skill development programmes such as Art and Craft sessions, computer sessions etc. and we also collect resources related to them at our own expense.

4. Infrastructure-

- We try to give a school-like environment to our children because there should also be a learning environment for studying.
- We want to teach children in such a place where they never feel that they are in a closed room but they are in a playground. That's why the infrastructure for learning is equally important.

5. Co-curricular activities-

- Apart from Studies, children also need to participate in co-curricular activities.
- It will be effective for their mental development as well as Physical development.
- We organize numerous co-curricular activities for them which is conducted evenly during the year.

6. Miscellaneous

- We treat children like our family, and we believe entertainment is equally important to keep them motivated and cheerful.
- Thus, we organize Educational Visits and fests for them from time to time at our own expense. We also take care of things related to their health.

Challenges and Problems

1. Accessibility and Infrastructure

- Many facilities, training centers, and workplaces are not fully accessible to persons with disabilities (PWDs) or blind individuals.
- Insufficient availability of tools and devices that enable PWDs to perform tasks efficiently.

2. Awareness and Social Barriers

- Low Awareness Among Employers many employers are unaware of the potential and capabilities of PWDs.
- Persistent stereotypes and discrimination can discourage participation and inclusion.

3. Skill Development and Training

- Mismatch of Skills and Job Requirements, training programs may not always align with industry demands, leading to employability gaps.
- Participants may have minimal access to up-to-date technologies or vocational practices.

4. Financial and Resource Constraints

- Insufficient resources can restrict the scale and reach of programs.
- Maintaining long-term support and continuous training for participants can be challenging.

5. Employment Opportunities

- There may be a shortage of inclusive workplaces willing to hire PWDs.
- PWDs may face difficulties adjusting to work environments without adequate support.
